

Check if working with children ticks all your boxes.



From 1 July 2019, employees and volunteers who work with children must by law have a working with children check.

The new working with children check replaces all other child-related employment screening checks.

If you work or volunteer with children, you have every reason to check that you've given it a big tick.

If you are working or volunteering with children, you will need a working with children check from 1 July 2019.



If you have a current child-related employment screening, it will be valid until it expires. Then you must have a working with children check.



If you have a current national police check, it will be valid until 1 July 2020. Then you must have a new working with children check.



You can apply for your own screening check.



Your new check is valid for 5 years.



Change jobs and the check goes with you.



The new check is free for volunteers.



From 1 July 2019, it's an offence not to have a working with children check.
