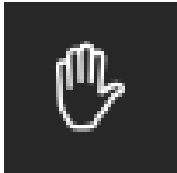

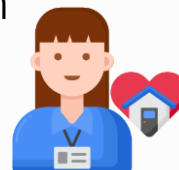

New pilot program for young people transitioning to adulthood from NGO non-family based care placements



# Stability Post Care Individual Packages Pilot

\$3.2 million over 4 years to support 18 young people to 21 years who:

- Are leaving non-government non-family based care
- Are at risk of homelessness
- Have complex needs

Aboriginal young people will comprise approximately 40% of the target group

Operating until 30 June 2027







Key focus on sustaining safe, suitable accommodation  
to prevent young people falling into homelessness





## Key service elements

- Housing outcomes for young people
- Practical support to help young people adapt to, and thrive in, adult life and their community
- Achieving outcomes in young people's life domains
- Individualised planning with young people
- Flexible brokerage funding

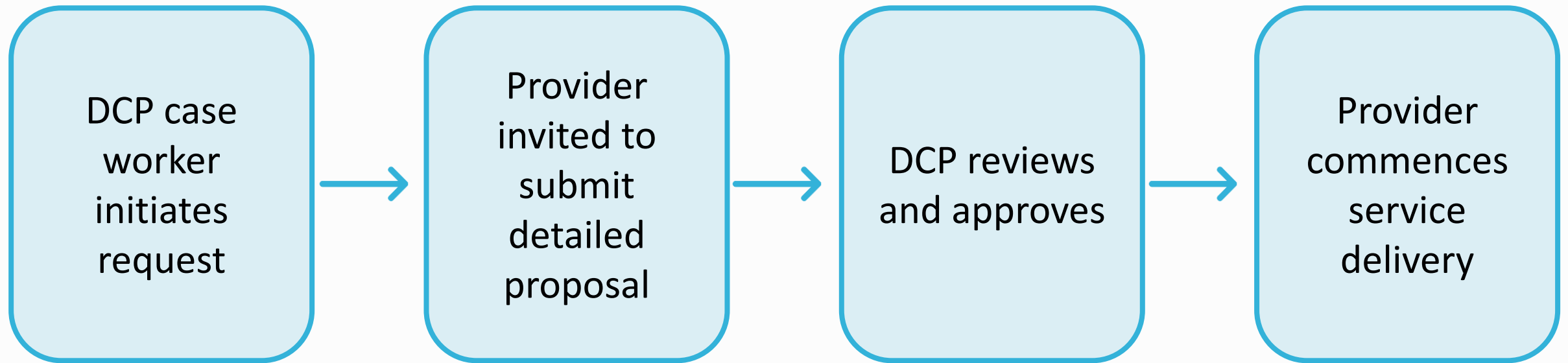


# Procurement approach

- Managed through Goods and Services Agreements
- Requests prepared by DCP case workers
- Suppliers invited to submit proposal
- Eligibility of suppliers
- Housing requirement
- Fixed price with no variations
