About this form

If you are a person who relinquished a child for adoption before 17 August 1989 you can restrict the release of information about yourself. This is called a veto.

Placing a veto means that no information that identifies you or allows you to be traced will be released to any other party. Other eligible parties are entitled to any other information in our possession that does not identify you or allow you to be traced. Under the *Adoption Act 1988*, the Minister may authorise disclosure of any information even if a veto is in place if that disclosure is necessary in the interests of the welfare of an adopted person. This is only under very exceptional circumstances and rarely occurs.

Please note that on 7 December 2016 legislation was passed in the South Australian Parliament to remove the adoption information veto system and phase it out over 5 years. It is intended these provisions will come into force in mid-2017.

Expiry, reminders and renewal

This veto is valid for five years only from the date we record. If you renew it now, your veto will automatically continue to the end of the 5 year period (mentioned on page 1) which is likely to commence in mid-2017. If you wish to cancel this veto at any time, you must do so in writing.

Proof of identity and change of name

For your protection, we require two documents proving your identity, **one of which must show your signature**. These can be *driver's licence, pension card, bank/credit cards, passport, full birth certificate, student card*.

DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS, photocopies are acceptable. **If you have changed your name since the adoption, copies of documents which prove your change of name must also be provided.** These can be *marriage certificate(s), change of name certificate(s)*.

This form can only be accepted from the person placing the veto. **Failure to provide sufficient identification will mean your veto is not officially lodged.**

Leaving a message

It can sometimes be distressing for a person applying for adoption information to find that a veto is in place. If they have some explanation as to why you placed this veto, it can help them to understand your position. If you wish to leave any message, explanation, information or item for another party, we will keep this until that party indicates their wish to receive it. **You can write a message in the space below. Please feel free to attach another page if you run out of room.**
